CCL Virtual Earth Day 2020: UNITING FROM HOME, with Dr. Katharinne Hayhoe Saturday, April 25, 1-4pm PDT

After hearing from Dr. Hayhoe, participants can take one of three easy actions from home to help the climate. Following the action, people can join one of four breakout sessions:

1. Climate Advocate Training: two-hour session gives newcomers tools to become effective climate advocates and the opportunity to learn more about CCL and how to participate with a local chapter.
2. CCL Volunteer Spotlight Panel: Moderated by Citizens' Climate Radio host Peterson Toscano, this session features a conversation with volunteers who are profiled in our documentary series.
3. Climate Organizing During the Pandemic: In this 90-minute session, CCL staffers will cover how to take action from home to move Congress forward on climate solutions.
4. Depolarizing Within: A Better Way to Prepare for Climate Discussions: Presented by Braver Angels (formerly Better Angels), 2-hour session helps participants take a more productive approach to engaging people we disagree with.
